Liverpool Trip

On Tuesday 22nd July, our Year 12 students will be out on a visit to the internationally acclaimed Albert Dock in Liverpool. Steeped in maritime history and home to the UK's largest number of Grade 1 listed buildings, here the students will have the opportunity to study the history and architecture of Liverpool's most visited tourist attraction, which is also home to a Maritime Museum, Tate Museum, the International Slavery Museum and the Beatles Museum. Students will be free to explore Liverpool Albert Dock or visit one or more of these museums at their leisure including The Museum of Liverpool, set on the waterfront, which contains exhibitions of local, national and international importance. In the afternoon they will also be free to explore the City including Liverpool One, Liverpool, one of Europe's leading retail and entertainment complexes.
