Greentech Academy was founded in 2017 and is run by the Director, Florence Ogutu. The school educates 36 students and has a primary one and primary two class.

Greentech Academy is severely underfunded and lacks basic facilities. The school only has two semi-permanent classrooms and five pit latrines.

Through the development work carried out by our volunteers, Greentech's aim is to open more doors for more children in their community by enrolling grade one students and onwards to make it a fully-fledged school.



Location

Greentech Academy is based in Nakuru, Kenya's fourth largest city. Despite the significant economic development Kenya has enjoyed over the last 10 years, there remains a distinct gap between rich and poor with 20% of the population living off less than \$2 per day. We're working with schools, like Greentech Academy that have been set up to give children the chance of a better future.
