## **GCSE Results Day and Sixth Form enrolment**

I hope you are having an enjoyable summer. Your GCSE results day is on Thursday 22nd August and you are invited to come into school to collect your GCSE and vocational course results. The doors open at 10am and a member of staff in the Heart will hand you your results envelope. They will also ask you about your post-16 plans; whether it's sixth form, college, apprenticeship etc. Journalists from the local newspaper will also be present and you may be invited to be interviewed and photographed for the Glossop Chronicle. Most of our students gain the grades to get them onto their next chosen pathway, however, if for any reason your results are not what you expected, teachers will be available to provide suitable advice and guidance around post-16 courses and / or the JCQ guidelines here can be followed.

If you are unable to collect your results in person from school on 22nd August, you have two options. First, your results will be emailed to your school email address after 12.30pm on the 22nd and you will be able to access them online. If you choose this option, please note that from August 1<sup>st</sup> all student emails in school will change slightly from @edu.glossopdale.school to @glossopdaleschool.org.uk. Your name/number login detail at the start of the email address remains the same. Your second option is to send a family member / friend to collect them for you on the morning of the 22nd. If you choose to send someone to collect your results, they must have signed a letter from you, stating that you are giving them permission to collect your GCSE results. They should also bring ID to confirm their identity and they need to collect them between 10am and 12 noon.

Once you have your results you will be able to complete your enrolment into the Sixth Form and secure your place on your chosen A Level and/or vocational courses. Members of the Sixth Form team will be available on the day to offer advice and guidance around course choices and future pathways. If you cannot attend in person, email Mrs Boakes, Sixth Form Year Manager on <u>kboakes@glossopdale.school</u> to arrange a telephone interview to secure your place. It's not too late to apply to join the Sixth Form, speak to Mrs Boakes who will be able to advise you.

Finally, if you ordered and paid for a yearbook via ParentPay, these will be available to collect on the day.
