Nakuru Grace Academy was founded in 1997 and is run by the Director, Margaret Iminza. The school educates around 200 students from the ages of three to 13.

Nakuru Grace Academy is severely underfunded and lacks basic facilities and equipment such as textbooks, which can be challenging for the teachers.

Through the development work carried out by our volunteers, Nakuru Grace Academy's aim is to keep children in education. They want to achieve this by constructing more classrooms so they can retain their students and offer a junior high education to them.



Location

Nakuru Grace Academy is based in Nakuru, Kenya's fourth largest city. Despite the significant economic development Kenya has enjoyed over the last 10 years, there remains a distinct gap between rich and poor with 20% of the population living off less than \$2 per day. We're working with schools, like Nakuru Grace Academy that have been set up to give children the chance of a better future.
