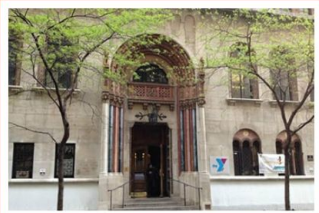
STEM TRIP – NEW YORK 2025/26

C Scheme

If you're aged between 13 and 24, you can sign up for a C-Card which gives you free condoms and lube. You can access the service whether you're male or female and whatever your sexual orientation. It doesn't matter whether you're having sex, thinking about having sex or if you're just curious.

You can sign up for a C-Card in school on a **Friday lunch time** in the Family Support Office or by attending the closest sexual health drop in at the Bureau – 22 Henry St, Glossop on the last Thursday of the month. You'll be asked a few details and it is completely confidential – The initial consultation will take approximately 10 minutes.

To collect further condoms and lube (once you've got your C-Card):

Visit any of the C-Card registered sites, you'll only need to show your C-Card and you'll be given safer sex supplies.

Once the card is issued, it can be shown at any site displaying the C-Card logo and you can get your new supplies.

Supplies will available on a **Friday lunch time** from the Family Support office.

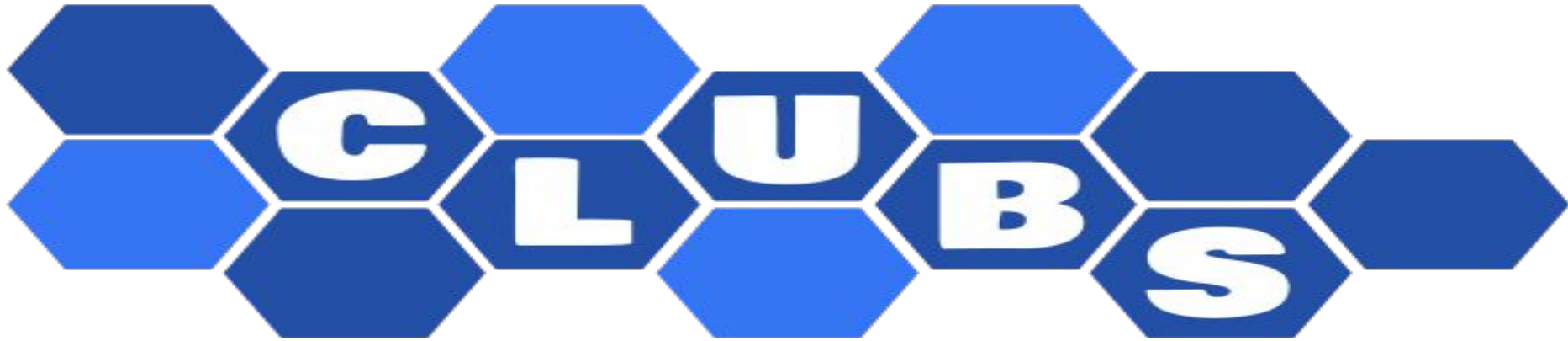




